Please be advised that the industry classification under which the shares of NEC Networks & System Integration Corporation on the Tokyo Stock Exchange will be changed, effective October 3, 2011, from “Construction” to “Information & Communication.” The change has been made by the Securities Identification Code Committee.

Accordingly, the position of the Company’s shares on the stock-related pages of newspapers will also change. However, the securities code will remain “1973.”

NEC Networks & System Integration Corporation has been evolving and expanding from a business focusing on the installation and construction of network infrastructure at the time of its listing in 1983, to a business providing comprehensive ICT services encompassing proposal, planning, systems integration, operation, maintenance, and cloud/outsourcing services for customers ranging from enterprises, through telecommunications carriers, to governments. A regular review on industry classifications was recently conducted by the Securities

Identification Code Committee. As a result of the examination, the Company met the Committee's criteria for changing industry classification.
